Ref: Dictionary: **Trouble:** 1. A state of distress, affliction, difficulty, or need: 2. A distressing or difficult circumstance or situation.
Affliction: 1. A condition of pain, suffering, or distress. 2. A cause of pain, suffering, or distress.
Sorrow: 1. Mental suffering or pain caused by injury, loss, or despair. 2. Expression of sorrow; grieving.
Mourn 1. To feel or express grief or sorrow.
